





Ready to File the FAFSA?

Here's What You'll Need

Filing for financial aid is less stressful when you are prepared. Use the checklists below to help you fill out the 2024-25 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).**

HELPFUL

***FSA ID

The FSA ID is a username and password that confirms your identity when signing the FAFSA. To sign the FAFSA online, the student needs an FSA ID. Dependent students will also need ONE parent to sign with a separate FSA ID. When creating an FSA ID you must

have access to your phone or email During setup you will be asked to verify your cell phone and/or email address by entering a code sent by text or email to the contact information listed. Learn more at icansucceed.org/fsaid

When should I file?

The 2024-25 FAFSA form will be available in December 2023, Each college has a priority date for the FAFSA. You should file the FAFSA before the priority date. If you are applying to multiple schools, file by the earliest date.

- Social Security number, driver's license number and date of birth.
- 2022 federal and state tax returns.
- W-2 forms and/or other records of income earned in 2022.
- ☐ As of today, what is the balance of checking, savings, and investment accounts?**
- ☐ Records of untaxed income received in 2022 (e.g., veterans benefits, etc.).
- 2022 business and farm records.
- Permanent Resident Card, if not a U.S. citizen.
- ☐ As of today, are you married or remarried? If married or remarried, what is the date of marriage? If divorced or separated, what is the date of divorce or separation?
- Child support paid and/or received in 2022.
- ☐ A federal student aid identification (FSA ID) username and password.***
- ☐ A list of the colleges/universities you wish to send the FAFSA to.

IRS Data Retrieval

The IRS Data Retrieval Tool within the FAFSA application can be used to automatically pull MOST of your 2022 tax information into your FAFSA application. You will still need to have copies of your 2022 taxes and W-2s on hand as a reference.

The FAFSA is a free form that may be completed without professional assistance via paper or online forms provided by the U.S. Department of Education.

Apply for College

Senior Year

- Finish high school strong (academics/involvement)
- Have two to five schools you're serious about and apply
- Beware of deadlines (admission, scholarship, housing and financial aid)

Apply for College

- Parts of application
 - Basic demographic information
 - College essay
 - Official high school transcript
 - ACT/SAT scores
 - Letters of recommendation
 - Activity resume
 - Fees (if any)
 - Interview
 - Any other steps required by schools



Federal Student Aid (FSA) ID

- FSA ID serves as your legal signature
- Create the FSA ID at
 - <u>www.studentaid.gov</u>
- ID to access the form



When to File the FAFSA

- FAFSA is available late December 2023/January 2024
- Each school has a priority date
 - Priority date is the recommended filing date
 - File by priority date for the best chance at financial aid
 - Applying to multiple schools? Use the earliest date

Tips for Filing the FAFSA

- Have federal tax forms and W2s on hand
- Read the directions carefully
- Ask questions
- Keep a copy for your records
- Complete the FAFSA each year



FAFSA Ready Iowa Events

- Goal: 60% statewide completion
- ▶ 2022-2023: 54.5% completion rate
- Free assistance program offering help completing the FAFSA
- Events held
 - ICAN Centers (virtually and in-person)
 - School-Based Events (grant or sponsored)
 - Community-Based Events (hosted by partner sites walk-in basis)





How Can Parents Help?
